# **ROADMAP**

### **PRAY DAILY**

Set a recurring alarm on your phone for 10:02a to remind you to pray the Luke 10:2 prayer ("pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into his harvest") and to pray for your neighbors you listed above.

### **INVEST WEEKLY**

Be intentional about moving toward your neighbors and cultivating a relationship with them by engaging them in conversation, asking them about their lives, listening to their hopes, and serving their needs.

#### INVITE TO THE NEXT RIGHT THING

Open your life to your neighbors and invite them into what you enjoy and who you enjoy it with. Our Sunday gathering or your City Night are great environments to personally invite your neighbors into. But don't confuse *being* the church to your neighbors with *bringing* your neighbors to church.
